THE UNIVERSE OF OPENNESS - THE SIXTH EDITION OF FORUM

Open Education initiatives have been expanding extraordinarily since the beginning of remote education. The global pandemic has changed radically the way we learn and due to the restrictions, almost 90% of all countries worldwide offered online learning. Open Education became a real game-changer during this time. That is why we would like to dedicate this year's Forum to the discussion about different aspects of OE that helped teachers, educators, parents and students during the unexpected and difficult time of remote education as well as challenges that we face with global climate changes and its relation with open education.

With so many various projects in progress and people involved in OE community, we want to ask the following questions:

- WHAT ROLE CAN OPEN EDUCATION PLAY AFTER THE PANDEMIC?
- HOW CAN WE ENSURE THE GROWTH OF THE IMPORTANCE OF OPEN EDUCATION IN EDUCATION:THE UPCOMING FUTURE?
- WHY RESEARCH IN THE FIELD OF OPEN EDUCATION IS SO IMPORTANT AND HOW CAN WE COLLABORATE TO TURN RESEARCH RESULTS INTO POLICY ACTIONS.
- HOW DO WE DEFINE GREEN 8 CLIMATE EDUCATION IN OPEN EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES. WHAT CAN WE DO AS THE OPEN EDUCATION COMMUNITY TO ACT MORE RESPONSIBLY AND SUSTAINABLY?

We came to the conclusion that our policymakers' world has also been affected by COVID-19 pandemic. In this workshop we want to focus on the global experience of remote life and how crises can inspire changes. How Open Education is important in such situations around the globe. Our goal is to define a plan for future policy work to take into action after the Forum in the upcoming year. The plan needs to be realistic and achievable. Participants of this workshop will be involved in pushing forward the conceptual work outlined in this class.

2. New concepts 8 perspectives for the study on copyright for education | 16:00 CET

During the Forum we will present our new pan-European study "Remote education during the pandemic: teachers perspective" which was run simultaneously in seven EU countries. We asked teachers about the materials, tools, methods, obstacles, and problems that they encountered during remote education to see how OE can respond to their needs.

In this workshop we will discuss why research is crucial for the further development of Open Education and show the best practices in studies of recipients' needs. Using the experience of creating a new research methodology, we want to ask stakeholders from different countries and with various experiences, how to adapt the research methodology to the needs of recipients in different parts of the world. We believe that the data obtained in studies can become the basis for more effective advocacy activities and changes in national education policies.

3. Open Education for Green & Climate Education | 16:00 CET

We are aware that Green & Climate Education has become an inseparable part of our daily lives. Often, however, it is not easy to introduce into educational institutions. Therefore, it is worth looking for new paths and connections, inspiration and good practices.

And such possibilities are offered by open education. We want to look at how the philosophy of open knowledge, data, open educational methods and OER can support actions related to climate education. Also at the system level, educational policies or the implementation of the sustainable development goals.

We want to strengthen the community of Green & Climate Education and create incubation space for sharing and creating your ideas.
